Scenario Facts

- Blue Pontiac Trans Am licence plate 123 ABC, 1 vehicle occupant
- Solid centre median
- Trans Am on its roof beside the median
- Alcohol is not a factor
- Hwy 401 east of Markham Road, Toronto
- January 31, 2004
- No injuries,
- Red Honda Civic licence plate number 321 DFB, 2 vehicle occupants
- What could have prevented the accident
- Animal enters the roadway from north ditch of highway
- White Chevrolet Lumina licence plate 977 TAB, uninvolved driver parked off roadway directing traffic
- Grey Ford Taurus licence plate CCF 987, 1 vehicle occupant
- Red paint on rear right bumper/corner of Ford Taurus
- Straight skid marks in lane 1 or 2 lane highway
- Grey paint on left front corner of Honda Civic
- Emergency lane change
- Temperature -10 degrees celsius, roads are dry
- Time of accident between 2:10 a.m and 2:45 a.m
- Appropriate charges for at fault driver
- All vehicles traveling westbound
- Skid marks veering to the right
- All vehicles have been moved to the north shoulder of the road before police arrival
